Submarine Support Facility Demolition

PEARL HARBOR, HI

NWDD was contracted to demolish various support structures within the Controlled Industrial Area of Pearl Harbor. NWDD mobilized a specialized high reach excavator to systematically wreck the taller onsite structures, preparing the suspended gantry system for removal via crane. The presence of contaminants such as PCBs, lead, and chromium required significant waste management coordination within the secure area. In total, over 4.100 tons of concrete and "special waste" was removed from site.



McMurdo Station Demolition

ROSS ISLAND, ANTARCTICA

Following the successful consulting effort at McMurdo Station in 2019, NWDD was retained to perform the demolition of various structures to aid in the redevelopment goals of the base. This involved both full scale structural demolition as well as the selective removal and interior preparations for work in future seasons.



RTK Cooling Tower Decommissioning

SALT LAKE CITY, UT

NWDD contracted with long-term client Rio Tinto to begin the decommissioning of their Kennecott Mine Power Plant. For this initial phase, NWDD removed a series of large cooling towers. Due to the presence of hazardous materials, the tower debris was carefully segregated and managed fully to final disposition.

The compressor building demolition consisted of a turbine compressor, miscellaneous equipment, and a robust support structure including an overhead crane.
